- Up to two boxes per family, per day. To donate, pull into a Curbside spot, and call the Curbside number. Staff will assist you.
- Books that seem collectible or valuable should be passed to the librarian working the desk for further review.

To help our staff, please limit the number of items donated.

Unacceptable Book Donations

We will NOT accept:

- Textbooks of any kind.
- Books without dust jackets.*
- Books with water damage, mold, pages missing, cracked bindings, strong odors, noticeable disrepair.
- Encyclopedias
- "Advanced Readers'" copies. (Marked "Not for Resale")
- Medical, diet and health, language, and/ or travel books more than 3 years-old.
