2715 30th Street, Rock Island, located in same building as the Rock Island YMCA

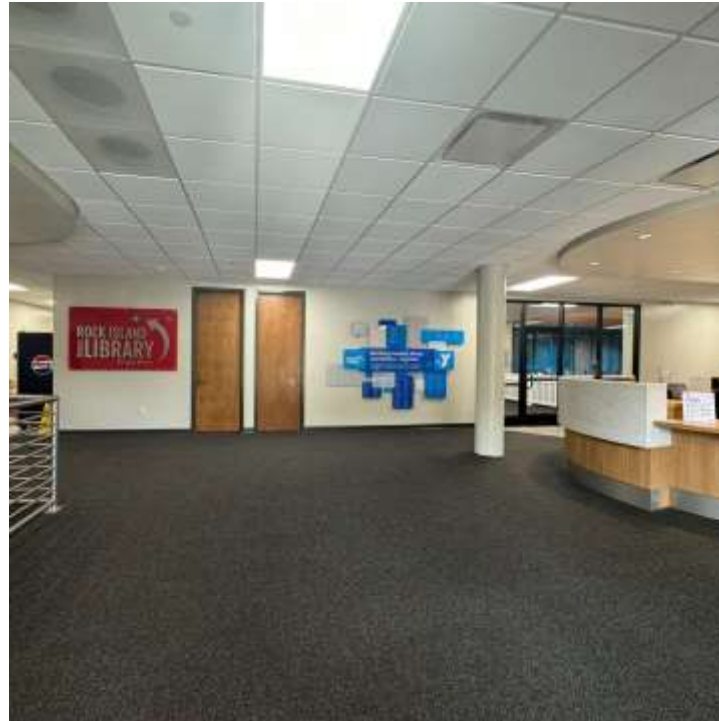
Shared Entrance Door with Parking



Arriving at the Watts-Midtown Branch:

This is the driveway off 30th Street that I follow to park in. It leads into the main entrance for both the Library and Rock Island YMCA. There is ample parking available.

Shared Lobby with YMCA



When I walk in through the front doors I see the YMCA to my right and the Rock Island Library to my left. Follow the hallway to the left of the sign down to our door.

Entering the Library:

I turn to my left and walk down the hallway that leads into the library's front entrance.

Inside the Library:

This is my library, **Rock Island Public Library- Watts Midtown Branch**. We come to the library to access information and services. There are books I can read, information I can research, and programs and services in which I can participate.

Picking Up Holds



Picking Up Held Items:

I can place books on hold in the library catalog, and pick them up at the Watts-Midtown Branch. If I want, I can request my items to be picked up in the locker inside the shared lobby. The Book Locker extends availability before and after library hours.

Children's Area



A Space for Kids:

When I walk into the library, there is a children's area behind the front desk. I can play and read here, and even listen in on story time.

Adult Sections



Books for Adults:

Past the Children's Area, I see bookshelves filled with Adult books. There are Large Print, Fiction, Mystery, Romance, Inspirational, and Non-fiction titles here.

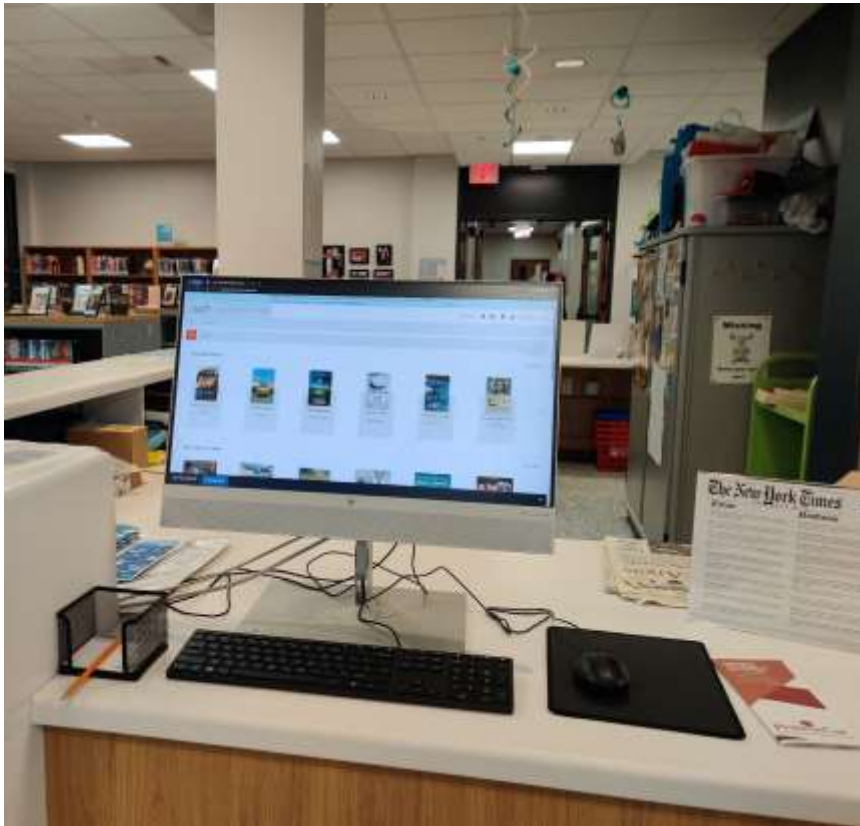
Teen Area



A Space for Teens:

In the back of the library, I see Young Adult materials, graphic novels, study tables, and more. Here I can hang out and charge my electronics while enjoying the view from the windows.

This is How I Find a Book at my Library.



Using the Online Catalog:

I can look for books in my library's online catalog. I can search by title or author or subject. I can do this on computers at the library or from home. There is also an app I can use on a mobile phone or other device. If I need help with finding items, I can ask desk staff.

Public Computer Stations



Internet and Wifi:

I can use the public computer stations to access the internet and print. I can log in with my library card number or ask staff for a guest pass. If I have my own device, I can also use the WiFi connection by looking for RIFI and accepting the terms of use.

Print / Copy / Outgoing Fax Nook



Printing and Copying:

I can print from the computers or from my mobile device. I can make copies here, or send an outgoing fax. I can also view what upcoming events are happening at the Library and in my community.

Study Rooms



Quiet Study Spaces:

If I need a quiet space, I can use one of the two study spaces that the Rock Island Library Watts-Midtown Branch provides.

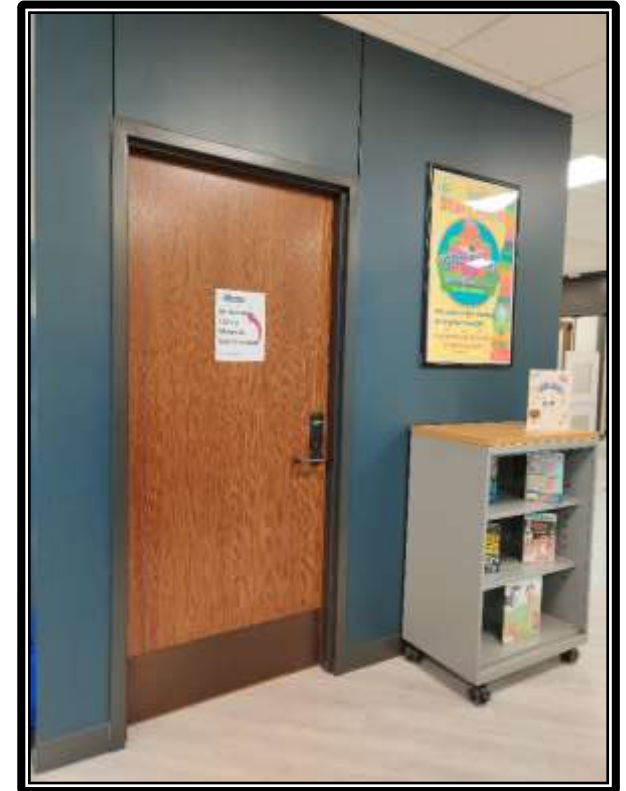
Rooms I Can Reserve for a Fee (If Available)



Booking Library Rooms:

If I need a bigger space, the library has a large community auditorium and a mid-sized conference room that are available for rental. I can reserve these online or at the library desk. Cash, check, or credit card are accepted.

Before I enter the library, I see two bathrooms to my right. A family restroom is available inside the Children's Area in the library.

Outdoor Space



Relax and Read Outdoors:

I can use the library's patio by walking through one of the two doors that leads outside. I can attend special library events here and enjoy the space on a nice day.

Returning My Library Items



Several Ways to Return Items:

I can return library items in several ways. outside in the book drop, in the box inside the lobby, or at the circulation desk.
